

College & University Immunization Compliance

DELAWARE

As stated in Delaware Administrative Code 4202 7.1.10, all full-time students are required to show proof of immunity to measles, rubella, and mumps. If a student has not met this requirement, they are not allowed to participate in enrollment.

Delaware college and university staff are faced with the challenge of manually collecting and processing student vaccine paper records prior to the start of each semester. 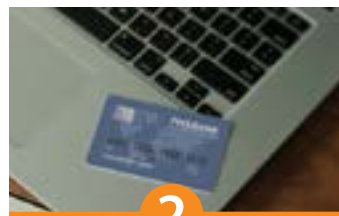
Students submit immunization records online

- Transferring students can download a copy of the immunization record to submit to their next school.



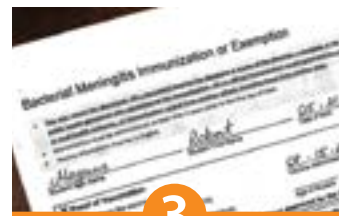
